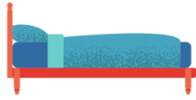


STORY AND MOVE TIME

Story tips:

1. Start with once upon a time.
2. To make a story exciting, go on an adventure (an adventure can be as big or small as you like).
3. Encourage children to be involved in creating the story by asking questions such as:
 - Where shall we go?
 - What do foxes eat?
 - What colour bus shall we be?
 - What food are we going to cook in our pot?
4. If they can, encourage children to create their own stories.
5. Make your movements as big and energetic as you can.
6. The story does not have to make sense, however stories (particularly active stories) are a great way to help children make sense of things.
